

## Materials needed for workshop:

Two fat quarters and several 3 to 4" squares for triangle tab 3/4 width metal carpenter tape
One half yard fusible lightweight batting 1/4 yard lightweight interfacing
Masking tape or duct tape

Kits are available from Barb (for \$5) consisting of lightweight batting, lightweight fusible interfacing, pre-cut carpenter measuring tape.

Fabric, trims and swivel snap are not included in kit. Kits must be requested by Jan. 24th.

If possible cut fabric before class: Lining fabric - 8 x 16 ½" Outer fabric - 8 x 13" Lightweight batting - 8 x 13" Fusible lightweight interfacing - 8 x 3 (2)


## **COMFORT QUILTS**

The purpose of a comfort quilt is to show the care and concern of our fellow quilting sisters going through a traumatic time in their life. The guidelines to receive a comfort quilt is as follows: personal health issues (cancer, transplant, major surgery), death of immediate family (parent, spouse, child) and life threatening situations (accident with injuries). A member may receive only one comfort quilt from the guild, even if they have different issues as stated above.

The designated "Sunshine" person in the guild is responsible for spreading sunshine and encouragement to those in the guild who need it. She will send get well, sympathy or other appropriate cards when notified. To be notified, someone in the guild calls/texts her with information about a person in need. This could be someone who has had surgery, or a hospital stay or a serious illness. She then sends her an appropriate card for the situation from the guild. There is a book she can log in the information to keep track of cards sent. She is responsible for purchasing cards/ stamps and turning in her expenses as needed.
