- Silent Auction: The last Quilt Show in 2022 brought in \$2,300. sold 70 items, 24 non-members paid \$1,397 and 30 SQG members paid \$903.

The 2024 show wants to increase revenue this May.

To increase revenue this year many techniques used in 2022 will carryover, as well as some untried ideas:

To increase revenue for the guild, the Silent Auction will include selling quilts and crafts that appeal to non-quilters like wooden crafts, gardening and decor will be sold as well as our own quilts.

The auction will sell items with a larger spread price range, some items will sell for \$10 while others sell beyond \$200+. All guests should enjoy and purchase a wide range of items.

The Silent Auction will <u>box</u> together items that sell at a higher value. For example, an animal quilt can be combined with a stuffed animal that will sell with higher price and attract more bids. A kitchen table runner that joins with a quilting recipe book or an attractive cooking apron that brings in more bids.

Collection Bins will be at the afternoon & evening guild meetings on March 7 and Apr 4th. Remember to put your name on a donation if you want to be recognized for your donation or if your item is not bid-on we can give it back to you.
